#### INSTRUCTIONS

stamp:

- \* Place some acrylic paint onto a piece of palette paper.
- of palette paper.
  \* Transfer the paint to the Art Foamie by rolling a brayer through the paint and then rolling the brayer onto the stamp.
- 3. Stamp in various locations across the brown paper, being sure to go off the edge of the paper.

# INSTRUCTIONS

Paper #2:

- 5.Remove handles (if from paper any) Cut the bag bag. open and remove the bottom section so that you have a long continuous piece of brown paper.
- 6. Stamp the Art Foamie onto the Stamp Buddy with a permanent black ink
- pad. 7.Fill the Stamp Buddy with acrylic paint (using a plastic card to âssist), following outline the you stamped.
- 8. Use the Stamp Buddy "paint as a stamp pad" and print across the brown in a brick paper pattern.



#### Ribbon:

- 1. Apply paint to the stamp:
- \* Place some acrylic
- paint onto a piece of palette paper. Transfer the paint to the Art Foamie by rolling a brayer through the paint and then rolling the brayer onto the stamp.

### TIPS

- Tile the smaller Art Foamies to create larger blocks.
- Add white paint to your colored paint to make it a bit more opaque on the dark background of the brown paper.
- \* Begin with larger Art Foamies.
- \* Choose colors that work together rather than fight with each other.
- similar \* Repeat shapes (such as circles) multiple times.
