## Quick Cards

A quick and easy way to make two cards from a sheet of Matte Computer Grafix with sentiments.

## **Supplies:**

Matte Computer Grafix
Grafix Double Tack Mounting Film
Grafix Artist-tac
Two 7x5 White Card Blanks
Alcohol Pens (Promarkers, Copic)
Colored Cardstock
Black Card Base
Computer
Printer
Copy Paper
Self-Adhesive Pearls and Ribbons



## **Directions:**

- 1. Open a new document within a word-processing program, choose 2 silhouette images from clip art and insert into the document with enough space so they can be cut out.
- 2. Then select two suitable sentiments to go with each image.
- 3. Print out the images and sentiments onto a sheet of Matte Computer Grafix. (*Note:* Adjust your printer settings to print on semi-glossy photo paper, for an optimal print).
- 4. Cut out each image and add color with the Alcohol Pens onto the reverse side.
- 5. Cut out each sentiment.
- 6. Apply Grafix Artist-tac to the reverse sides of the sentiments and images, and then mount onto white copy paper.
- 7. Take the images and sentiments and mount them onto the black card, leaving an even narrow border around the edges.
- 8. For each card, cut a sheet of colored cardstock to fit the front of the card blank with a narrow border then mount with Grafix Double Tack Mounting Film.
- 9. Adhere to the card blank and then add the images and sentiments.
- 10. To finish, add self-adhesive pearls and ribbon.
