Monoprint Note Cards

Rise and shine with these colorful Monoprint note cards made with Grafix Wet Media Dura-Lar, Super Sanded Shrink Film, and Artist-tac.

Supplies:

Grafix .004 Wet Media Dura-Lar Film Grafix Super Sanded Shrink Film Grafix Artist-tac Gelli Arts Gel Printing Plate Gelli Arts Mini Printing Tools Canson XL Mixed Media Paper StazOn Ink **Rubber Stamps** Acrylic Paint Brayer Handmade Foam Stamps Kraft Card Stock for Card Bases White Card Stock for Card Fronts 1/4" Scor-Tape Adhesive **Colored Pencils Embroidery Floss** Scraps of Burlap Scissors **Paper Trimmer**



Directions:

- 1. Start by creating a sketched image of a chicken or tracing a printed image of the chicken have (you can use a different image if you prefer).
- 2. You'll want to trace 4 copies of this image on Grafix Wet Media Dura-Lar Film to make 4 stencils.
- 3. Then cut the stencils out.
- 4. You can place your stencils on the Gelli Arts Gel Printing Plate now or after you have finished making the backgrounds.
- 5. Using the gel plate, add your choice of acrylic paints, you can use a brayer to blend the colors.
- 6. Designs can be created using Gelli Arts Mini Printing Tools and handmade foam stamps.
- 7. Once you are happy with the design place a piece of Canson XL Mixed Media Paper over the design to create the Monoprint.
- 8. You will create a few background pages repeating steps 3-4.
- 9. Place the chicken stencils on the four corners of the Gelli Arts Gel Printing Plate and add the acrylic paint and blend with a brayer. You can use Gelli Arts Mini Printing tools and handmade Foam Stamps to create designs on the chickens.



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- 10. Place the dried background design paper over the top of the painted chicken stencils.
- 11. Once the papers are dry, you can cut them up into four squares, $4 \frac{1}{4}$ by $5 \frac{1}{2}$.
- 12. To add an extra embellishment, trace your chicken design onto Grafix Super Sanded Shrink Film with a colored pencil.
- 13. Use your colored pencils to color the chicken design in.
- 14. Then take your favorite rubber stamp and StarsOn Ink to stamp the Shrink Film chicken design, 4 totals.
- 15. Then cut out the Shrink Film chicken designs.
- 16. Follow the shrinking instructions on the back of the Shrink Film package.
- 17. While the Shrink Film chicken designs cool, take the embroidery floss then cut out six stands of the colored thread for each card.
- 18. Then place a bunch of 6 stings at the bottom of the background and secure the strands in the back with Scor-Tape Adhesive.
- 19. Place a single knot on the front of the background design.
- 20. Then take a little scrap of burlap and attach it over top of the bunch of strings with Grafix Artist-tac.
- 21. Lastly, add the shrunken chicken designs to the burlap piece with Artist-tac.
