

Halloween DIY Trick or Treat Framed Graftix Cling Vinyl Art

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DIY your own chic Halloween decorations this year with only a few simple tools and Graftix Cling Vinyl Film and Chipboard. This project would make for a great gift too!

Supplies:

Graftix White Cling Vinyl (size 9x12")
Graftix Black Chipboard (size 8.5x11")
Picture Frames (size 8.5x11")
Cutting Machine
Scraper
Transfer Paper (optional)

Directions:

1. Decide what design you want to display on your DIY frame(s).
2. Then take a sheet of Graftix White Cling Film and place onto a cutting mat and cut out your design. **NOTE:** Here are the sizes we used for our Framed Vinyl Art. Spider web: 8.650" H x 11.151" W, Spider: 4.075" H x 1.977" W, Trick: 2.146" H x 7.311" W, Or: 0.946" H x 1.610" W, Treat: 1.949" H x 7.427" W.
3. Once all your pieces are cut-out, prep your glass frames by wiping the glass clean on both sides.
NOTE: This project used water and applied the Cling Film design to the outside of the frame.
4. Slowly peel away Cling Film from the backing while placing your design directly onto the glass. (Due to the intricate web design the film might get a little tangled. But, don't worry it's easily untangled and is quite easy to work with).
5. Take a scraper and remove any trapped bubbles by pressing down on the Cling Film until smooth.
6. Take a piece of Graftix Black Chipboard and place it onto the back of the glass.
7. Finish by fully assembling the backing of the board securely to the frame.
8. Repeat steps 4-7 for the remaining frames and designs.
9. Lastly, hand your new creation on a wall or give as a gift!
