## **NOLA ATC with Grafix Opaque White Craft Plastic**

## Create this fun ATC in the spirit of being in New Orleans using a variety of Grafix materials!

## Supplies:

Grafix Opaque White Craft Plastic / Dura-Bright Grafix White Mask liquid frisket kit – 2 oz.
Clear Dura-lar - .005" for overlay and stencil
Grafix Shrink Film - purple or green
Purple & Green alcohol ink
Amsterdam Gold Acrylic Ink.
Black Staz-on ink
Fleur-de-lis stamp
Mini - tiny attacher.
Adhesive – Grafix Double Tack Mounting Film



## **Directions:**

- 1. Cut Opaque white craft plastic and Clear Dura-Lar to 2.5 x 3.5."
- 2. On the Opaque white, trace stencil with a pencil.
- 3. Fill in the trace with White Mask Liquid Frisket & Incredible Nib, let dry.
- 4. While the frisket is drying, stamp the fleur-di-lis stamp onto the clear dura-lar with Staz-on ink and set aside.
- 5. Once the Frisket is completely dry (you can speed it up by using heat, just don't get too close as it will bubble if you do), drop on a few drops of purple alcohol ink and move it around until you like the way it looks.
- 6. Next add some drops of the green alcohol ink on the opposite side of the purple and move it around until you like how it looks. You will want to be careful not to overlap the purple and green colors too much as they will make a muddy color.
- 7. Once the inks are dry, remove the frisket.
- 8. After the frisket is removed, place the clear dura lar on top and staple the two together with a Tim Holtz Tiny Attacher (or any stapler).
- 9. Cover the staple with a shrink plastic charm using Double Tack Mounting Film.
