Journal Cover with Liquid Frisket

Create a mixed media journal cover using alcohol inks and watercolor!

Supplies:

- Grafix Incredible Frisket Kit (Incredible White Mask Liquid Frisket, Incredible Nib, Rubber Cement Pick Up)
- Grafix Double Tack Mounting Film
- Grafix Mixed Media Journal with Opaque Craft Plastic
- Previously made watercolor artwork (or anything else that you've created)
- Exacto knife
- Self-healing mat (or thick cardboard)
- Kamar varnish
- •UV Protection Glossy



Directions:

- 1. Grab your Incredible Frisket kit, some water and a paper towel.
- 2. Use the Incredible Nib and Frisket to lay down the masking for your design on the cover page of your mixed media journal (sketched out lightly with a pencil beforehand if needed).
- 3. Wait for it to fully dry before moving on. The frisket should look translucent and no longer opaque/white.
- 4. Add your alcohol ink colors to the page.
- 5. Once dry, use your Rubber Cement Pick Up to remove the frisket.
- 6. Seal your cover page with 1-2 layers of kamar varnish and UV protection.
- 7. Grab your watercolor artwork and use an exacto knife to cut out the design for your journal cover.
- 8. Use Double Tack Mounting Film strips to adhere your watercolor cut-outs onto the cover.
- 9. Stick it into your journal and start creating!
- 10. This journal is great for playing with ink combinations, testing how one ink color behaves, experimenting with mixed media ideas, etc.
