

Dura-Lar and Dura-Bright Bookmarks

Learn to make these cool, fun, and colorful bookmarks using Graftix materials!

Supplies:

- Graftix Opaque Black Craft Plastic / Dura-bright
- Graftix Opaque Grey Craft Plastic / Dura-bright
- Graftix Matte Dura-Lar Film
- Graftix Inking Palette
- Graftix Low Tack Frisket Film Matte
- Royal Talens Amsterdam acrylic paint 120ml
 - Azo yellow light, Turquoise blue, brilliant green, Naphthol red deep
- Hero Arts
 - Novel Prose, Flower market, Circular grid
- Jacquard alcohol ink
 - - JAC9918 and JAC9917 exciter packs
- Marcy Uchida Decocolor acrylic paint markers
 - bright set, primary set, classic set
- Cosmetic sponges
- Scissors
- StazOn ink in black
- Alcohol Ink pouncer handles.
- Ribbon



Directions:

1. Cut out shapes from the frisket film and stick them onto the Graftix surface.
2. Apply a layer of medium (paint or alcohol ink).
3. Dry the medium before moving to the next step.
4. Repeat steps 1-3 until you have 3 layers.
5. Gently peel the frisket film off the Graftix surface.
6. Use an acrylic paint pen to doodle and outline your shapes to complete the background.
7. Use a stamp with StazOn and stamp an image onto Graftix Wet Media Dura-Lar.
8. Layer the Graftix Wet Media Dura-Lar on top of your painted background and punch a hole in the top of both layers.
9. Tie a ribbon through both holes to keep the layers together.
10. Enjoy your new bookmark!
